Thank you for downloading LHF Desire Rough and Ragged. Please, take a few minutes to read over the important information below.

If your design software has access to the glyphs palette then please only install the Desire Rough Pro and Desire Ragged Pro, As this keeps all of the kerning intact and you have access to all of the alternates, ligatures, catchwords and flourishes.

Examples of design software that use the glyph's palette are Illustrator, InDesign, Corel and various others.

If your software does not have a glyphs palette then you can either use the windows character map (if you are on a PC) or an outside character map, such as Babelmap. Another good one is PopChar (for Mac).

Note: Since Desire Rough and Desire Ragged contain over 800 glyphs they can be memory intensive. If your computer is older and you find LHF Desire Rough Pro or LHF Desire Ragged Pro bogging your system down or crashing your drawing program then please install LHF Desire Rough A-E and LHF Desire Ragged A-E. These files have the alternate characters spread out over 5 fonts making them more manageable for older systems.

The key guides allow you to view the glyphs contained in each font. The alternates for each font are in colored boxes. When viewing the LHF Desire Rough Pro and LHF Desire Ragged Pro key guides you will notice the alternates are in boxes of various colors. These colors denote how the alternates were separated into their corresponding A-E font files.
